MEDOC and the 1855 CLASSIFIED CHATEAUX

Red Wine (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot)

- ✤ 9am Pick-up at your Hotel. Medoc region by the scenic Route des Châteaux
- First stop in the town of Margaux for a short panoramic driven tour.

10am Appellation MARGAUX

DAY 1

Private visit & tasting at a Top Growth **Château** (Grand Cru Classé) Tour of this 19th century domain, followed by a technical tour and a tasting of the 2 wines produced by the Chateau.

11.30am Appellation SAINT-JULIEN

Private visit & tasting at a Top Growth Château (Grand Cru Classé)

Tour of the cellar and vat house, followed by a tasting of 3 wines

LUNCH at a typical restaurant in the heart of Pauillac, Saint-Julien or Haut-Medoc regions. Local dishes, wines by the glass or by the bottle.

3pm Appellation PAUILLAC

Private visit & tasting at a Top Growth Château (Grand Cru Classé)

Visit of the underground cellar, of the prestige old bottle collection, followed by a Tasting of 3 wines

* 4pm Appellation SAINT-ESTEPHE

Private visit & tasting at a Top Growth **Château** (Grand Cru Classé) Family-run Chateau, tour hosted by the owner. Tasting of 4 wines

DAY 2

PESSAC-LEOGNAN & SAINT-EMILION & POMEROL

Red Wine (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc)

* 9.30am Pick up at your hotel

10am Appellation PESSAC-LEOGNAN

<u>Private visit & tasting</u> at a Top Growth **Château (Grand Cru Classé des Graves)** This may be the oldest domain from the Graves region, situated in the suburbs of the city of Bordeaux. Visit of the vat room, of the cellar, tasting of 2 wines (red & white)

* 12pm Appellation SAINT-EMILION

<u>Private visit & tasting</u> at a 1st Top Growth **Château (Premier Grand Cru Classé)** Tour of the vineyards, of the vat room, of the cellar, of the underground old wine collection, and of the unique 13th century underground quarries. Tasting of 4 wines

- LUNCH at a rooftop restaurant. Typical dishes and view overlooking the vineyards
- Guided tour of the medieval village of Saint-Emilion, UNESCO classified: the narrow streets, the Bell Tower, the Cloisters, the King's Tower, the ruins of the Great Wall, the gates of the fortified town.

4pm Appellation POMEROL

Private visit & tasting at a family-run Château

The owner will welcome and introduce you to the art of the winemaking.

After a barrel tasting of the current vintage, you will continue with a vertical tasting.

5pm Appellation SAINT-EMILION

Private tasting at Château (Grand Cru)

Experience a tasting of 4 or 5 different wines from various terroirs, such as clay, limestone, gravel & sand, clay & sand, and their influence on the Merlot grapes. Tasting paired with chesses.

6.30pm Drop off at your hotel.
